8. Research plan-a template which contains a proposal for the research you wish to undertake at the host university; only after having checked the academic offer from the host university
9. Language certificate (for the language of instruction of the respective study programme)
10. Motivation letter

12. Two recent passport photos
13. Invitation letter from a professor at the host university that is willing to guide you on your research

* Students benefiting from an Erasmus+ mobility will not be charged any tuition fees at the host university. Students will continue paying their tuition and registration fees in their home university (university of Haifa).

Students will receive an EU grant as a contribution to their costs for travel and subsistence during the period of study abroad

1) Travel costs

Based on the travel distance per participant, students and staff going to/coming from partner countries will receive the following support for their travel costs:

Travel distances	Amount
Between 100 and 499 KM:	180 EUR per participant
Between 500 and 1999 KM:	275 EUR per participant
Between 2000 and 2999 KM:	360 EUR per participant
Between 3000 and 3999 KM:	530 EUR per participant
Between 4000 and 7999 KM:	820 EUR per participant
8000 KM or more:	1100 EUR per participant

Travel distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by European Commission (http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance_en.htm). The distance of a one-way travel must be used to calculate the amount of EU grant that will support the round trip. The amount for the travel costs will be transferred by the host university directly to the grantees' bank accounts (opened in Euro in the country of the host university bank).

2) Subsistence for students during their studies

Group 2 Programme Countries with medium living costs	Belgium, Croatia ,Czech Republic, Cyprus, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain, Turkey
Group 3 Programme Countries with lower living costs	Bulgaria, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia
